We welcome you to join us as we share fun times, make great memories and most of all have fun!!

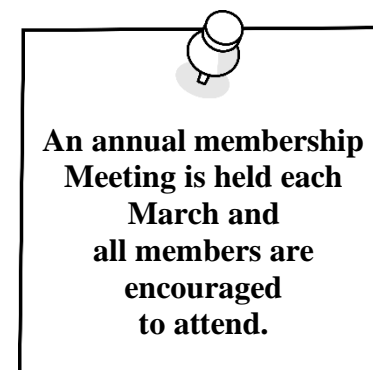
From the Board of Trustees

This clubhouse provides a dedicated area specifically designed for AA and Alanon meetings. Our membership area includes: A place to relax, watch games and events on TV, a private room for sponsors and sponsees to meet and more is coming as our members discover what would be nice additions to our space.

The How it Works Clubhouse is a non-profit facility that provides space for AA and Al-Anon meetings. It is **not** necessary to be a Member of the clubhouse to attend a meeting. As with any meeting, *“There are no dues or fees...”*

People join the Clubhouse to show their appreciation for the place that contributes to their lives, to carry the message of recovery to others, and to contribute to the operating costs of the facility.



As of January 2017:

The How It Works Clubhouse Rules

- Regular hours of the clubhouse are 6:00 am to 11:00 pm with the exception of special events. Premises must be vacated on a nightly basis, overnight sleeping or parking is prohibited.
- Use or possession of alcohol or drugs on the premises is strictly forbidden
- The building, entrances and walkways are to remain smoke free. Smoking is permitted in the parking lot only and butts are to be disposed of in the receptacle provided
- Conduct detrimental to the facility or its functioning is not permitted at any time
- All conduct is subject to the ruling of the Board of Trustees
- No gambling is permitted on the premises
- Panhandling and/or soliciting are not permitted at any time
- Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times
- No pets are allowed in the building at any time, with the exception of leashed service animals.
- Shirts and shoes are required at all times
- Everyone is expected to share in the responsibilities of helping to keep the facility clean and discarding waste/refuse or recycling (CLEAN plastic/cans/cardboard/paper) in the appropriate bins
